

# **IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING THE NSO SUNDAY, MARCH 25<sup>th</sup> CONCERT**

Dear NSO Patron,

The NSO is sharing some very important information which impacts the Sunday, March 25th concert and future concerts.

School District 225 has revised their school security policies and procedures to ensure a safe environment during regular and after school hours, especially for special events.

We thank you for your cooperation and support as these changes are implemented.

## **Entrance to the GBN Sheely Center – a few options**

- Use the **stairs or ramp** that lead to the front door entrance of Sheely Center and into the lobby. **This entrance will be opened at 2:00pm.**
- **Door F just east of main entrance to Sheely Center will be opened at 2:00 pm.** This entrance may be used by all patrons, **but it is especially helpful for individuals with mobility issues. There are no stairs and you can access the side entrance to the auditorium on house right. There will be signage and individuals on site to assist you.**
- **Door KK on the north side** of the building complex by the cafeteria will be available for patron access starting at **2:00 PM.**
- For security reasons **Stage Door L**, by the loading dock, can no longer be used as an entrance or exit. **Door F replaces it.**

## **Parking**

- We also want to alert you that the Northbrook Park District is holding an event in the GBN Fieldhouse from 2:30 PM until 4:30 PM. The NSO has made arrangements with GBN to have the **2 parking lots in front and to the east of the Sheely Center blocked off for our patrons use and they will be staffed by two parking attendants.**

We ask that you consider all these factors in the timing of your arrival at GBN on Sunday. We do plan on starting the concert promptly at 4:00 PM.
